

# Hang Your Glass

PRECISE VERSATILE **STURDY**

## **REMOVE STAND-OFF**

*Once your stand-off is properly adhered the adhesive is actually stronger than the glass. If you decide you need to remove a stand-off for any reason the only way to do so is with approximately 450° F of heat.*

*We do not recommend using heat guns because you are likely to shock the glass, which will cause it to break. Heat also makes the adhesive brittle. Only use heat when you intend to remove a stand-off.*

## **DIRECTIONS FOR REMOVING STAND-OFF**

1. Place piece back into kiln with stand-offs facing up.
2. Turn kiln on and begin to heat up to 450° F. At about 450° the adhesive will return to its viscous state.
3. Push the stand-off off the glass with a pair of tongs. Leave on the kiln shelf, fiber paper or place hot stand-off on concrete floor.
4. Bring the temperature of the kiln back down to room temperature.
5. Remove glass from the kiln.
6. Use screwdriver to remove excess adhesive off the glass. Do not re-use stand-off.
